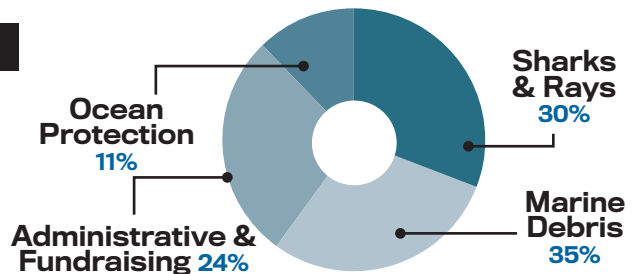

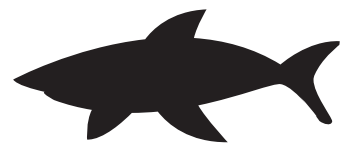

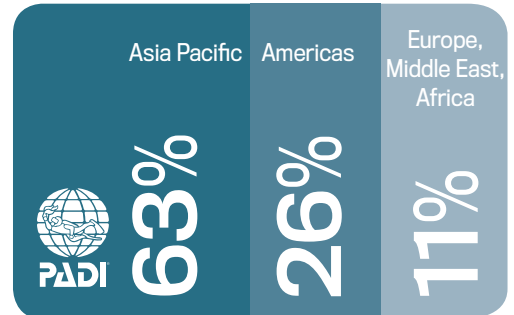

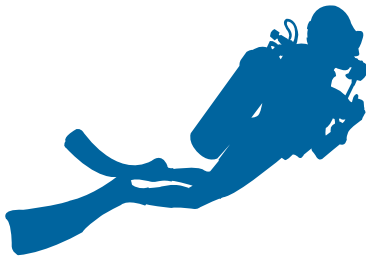

Protecting the ocean beneath the waves is unique and critical work. Infinite thanks to the global volunteers taking action to protect our ocean planet – one dive at a time.

Thanks to your generosity we are able to continue building on some of our amazing accomplishments of 2015 when we:

» Highlighted the devastating impacts of marine debris and emphasized the urgent need to find solutions to international political, academic and civil society figures as well as industry, philanthropy and nonprofit leaders at the Our Ocean 2015 conference.

» Trained and supported an army of volunteers to take action against underwater trash and save ocean wildlife anytime, anywhere. Dive Against Debris™ volunteers removed and reported more than 68,000 trash items from underwater environments in 2015.

» Fought to protect threatened sharks and rays – together we pushed to strengthen shark finning bans in the regional fishery management areas of the Atlantic and Indian ocean, advocated to put caps on catches of

blue and shortfin mako sharks and protect porbeagles in the Atlantic, and helped secure mandate for safe release of manta and devil rays caught in the tuna fisheries of the Eastern Pacific.
